Task:

- Your job is to showcase your assigned housing style in a Power-point, with a minimum of 16 slides.
- As a group you will be “selling” your housing style to the class and demonstrating it’s aesthetically pleasing properties. Your audience should be able to connect the exterior of the design to the preferred interior attributes.
- Use as many slides as you need to present (you should have a minimum of 16 slides):
 - Title page with picture
 - Definition of style with a picture
 - An architect or origin of house style
 - Region this style is most prominent and why
 - Four different “detail” slides found on a façade, with pictures (these slides should contain a title only. You will be the information and it must be written on cards)
 - Window styles (including name)
 - Doorway styles (including name)
 - Roofing styles (including name)
 - Siding styles (including name)
 - Three different slides with three different versions of your style. (Make sure you choose images that are varied, so you can show all the different ways your style can look)
 - Two different slides, each with a room decorated in the style of the house. You must choose two different rooms in the house. (You will explain what features in the room determine it’s style)
 - Three slides: A floor plans in your style (from floorplans.com):
 - Include a picture of the outside
 - List the square footage of your floorplan
 - Include in your Powerpoint slide the cost to build (from floorplans.com)
