



New Hampshire Association of Family & Consumer Sciences 2018 Scholarship Guide

** Deadline: March 23, 2018 **

Eligibility Requirements:

1. The 2018 NHAFCS Scholarship is based on leadership, experience and career goals.
2. The scholarship applicant must be a resident of New Hampshire.
3. The applicant must have a GPA of 3.0 or higher.
4. The student must have completed a minimum of 2 or more Family and Consumer Sciences or FCS-related courses.
5. There must be one recommendation from a FCS teacher who taught applicant.
6. There must be one recommendation from a teacher/guidance counselor.
7. The form must be filled out correctly and directions followed.
8. This is a non-renewable award.
9. The application is subject to change from year to year.

Enrollment:

All applicants must be enrolled in an accredited school on a full-time basis in the fall semester 2017. Proof of enrollment would be a billing statement from the school. Graduate School students are also eligible for this award.

Instructions:

The NHAFCS Scholarship Application consists of:

1. Student application with attached essay
2. FCS teacher recommendation who taught applicant
3. Teacher / Guidance Counselor recommendation
4. 2017-2018 Official High School or college transcript in a sealed envelope

1. A \$1000 scholarship will be awarded in June, 2018.
2. The award will be sent by check to the college/institution in January 2019 for tuition purposes only.
3. It is contingent upon successful completion of the first semester.
